A parish starts with the **Level 1** dashboard. This has 11 dashboard lights, as listed above.

When 8 of these lights are turned green, the parish progresses to the **Level 2** dashboard. This move automatically happens overnight, and it enables the parish to make a list of any church activities for children, young people or adults at risk. They can then access a mini dashboard for each activity

A parish must approve the list of church activities (or confirm that there are none) before progressing to the **Level 3** dashboard. This move automatically happens overnight when most of the Level 2 lights are turned green.
